

Supplementary rules of conduct in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic (valid from 20 April to 3 May 2020)

In addition to the rules of conduct published by us on 9 April, the following corona rules apply from 20 April:

- Contact restrictions are principally extended until May 3rd.
- The Federal Government **urgently** recommends the wearing of everyday masks on public transport and when shopping; there is, however, no general obligation to wear everyday masks.
- Special protective measures should be taken for nursing homes and facilities for the elderly and disabled.
 - From 27 April onwards, school lessons should be gradually resumed: The first step will be taken by the graduating classes, from 4 May the next younger classes will follow.
Examinations of the final classes should take place after appropriate preparation.
 - The last class of primary school should also be allowed back into school.
- The emergency care in the day-care centres is to be continued and expanded.
- Major events will remain prohibited until 31 August.
- Shops with a sales area of up to 800 square meters may reopen as early as April 20 under certain hygiene conditions.
- Car dealers, bicycle dealers and bookstores may reopen, as may cultural institutions such as libraries, archives as well as zoological and botanical gardens.
- Service providers where physical closeness is unavoidable, such as hairdressers, may reopen from 4 May onwards, subject to certain conditions and with personal protective equipment.
- Restaurants, bars and pubs remain closed.
- Gatherings in churches, mosques and synagogues as well as religious celebrations and events and gatherings of other religious communities remain prohibited.
